Bankruptcy Information

The Bankruptcy process can be a difficult time for people. When the decision to file bankruptcy is made, most clients feel a large burden is lifted from their shoulders. Bankruptcy laws help people who can no longer pay their creditors get a fresh start – by liquidating assets to pay their debts or by creating a repayment plan.

If you have decided to file bankruptcy, then you need to complete the packet of information which was provided to you at your office visit. In addition to returning that information, you will need to provide the following information:

1. 2 years of tax returns
2. 6 months of pay check stubs
3. Bank statements for all bank accounts that are currently open
4. Copy of your social security card and driver's license
5. Copy of all recent billings for your creditors
6. Copy of last 2 month of utility billings
7. Copy of all vehicle registrations and if you have them the vehicle titles
8. If you have a retirement account - current statement showing value of retirement account and, depending on the type of retirement account, any information showing whether you are vested or how soon you will be vested in your account
9. If you either pay or receive child support or alimony - the name of the person either paying or receiving the payments, the case number of the Court's order requiring the payment, and information regarding which county ordered the payments
10. If you own/buying your home - any recent appraisal, current real estate taxes, copies of your loan documents
